

BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE MIDDLESEX COUNTY COLLEGE

Minutes of the Meeting of September 26, 2007

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College was held at 7:16 p.m. in the Chambers Hall Boardroom. Members present were: Ms. Palumbo, Messrs. Bauer, Finkelstein, Piegari, Raja, Sica and Tighe. Mmes. Kannusamy, Power and Messrs. Mulkerin and Rivas were absent. Also present were President La Perla-Morales, Mr. Hoffman, Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all courses and programs in the Departments of English as a Second Language (ESL) and Modern Languages/Center for International Education be transferred to the newly created Department of ESL/Languages and Cultures within the Division of Social Sciences and Humanities effective fall semester 2007.
