

BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE MIDDLESEX COUNTY COLLEGE

Minutes of the Meeting of September 24, 2008

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College was held at 9:00 a.m. in the Chambers Hall Boardroom on the College campus. Members present were: Mmes. Palumbo, Power and Sutera and Messrs. Bauer, Finkelstein, Mulkerin, Raja, Rivas, Sica, and Tighe. Messrs. Antisell and Piegari were absent. Also in attendance were Dr. La Perla-Morales, Freeholder Rios, Mr. Hoffman, Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.

In compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act" of the State of New Jersey, adequate notice of this meeting was provided as follows:

- (a) On July 9, 2008, advance written notice of this meeting was posted in the lobby of Chambers Hall.
- (b) On July 9, 2008, advance written notice of this meeting was mailed to The Home News Tribune, 35 Kennedy Boulevard, East Brunswick, New Jersey and The Star Ledger, 131 Ethel Road, Piscataway, New Jersey.
- (c) On July 9, 2008, a copy of the advance notice of this meeting was filed with the Clerk of the Middlesex County Board of Chosen Freeholders.
- (d) On July 9, 2008, a copy of this advance notice was filed with the President of Middlesex County College.
- (e) Any individual who has requested notice of this meeting has been forwarded a copy of the notice of such meeting.

Chairman Power led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Sica moved, seconded by Mr. Mulkerin, that the regular meeting minutes of August 27, 2008, be adopted as presented. After discussion, the motion was unanimously approved.

ACADEMIC, STUDENT AND ALUMNI AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

Mr. Raja moved, seconded by Mr. Bauer, for adoption of resolutions 1 through 3:

1. WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") and the State of New Jersey, Commission on Higher Education (hereinafter referred to as the "State") have entered into a contract for the operation of a project entitled CENTRAL REGIONAL CONNECTIONS for the period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, a proposal entitled CENTRAL REGIONAL CONNECTIONS has been submitted by the College and agreed to by the State in the amount of \$115,000; and

WHEREAS, R.S. 18A: 64A-12J grants the Board the power to enter into contracts which it deems necessary and advisable with the State of New Jersey or any of its political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the operation of a project entitled CENTRAL REGIONAL CONNECTIONS is consistent with the philosophy and purpose of the College,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- a. The Board approves the proposal for the operation of a project entitled CENTRAL REGIONAL CONNECTIONS, as submitted by the College to the State of New Jersey, Commission on Higher Education, for the period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009, in the total amount of \$115,000.
- b. The Board herein ratifies the contract executed by the College President and the State of New Jersey.

2. WHEREAS, an application entitled NEW JERSEY BONNER LEADERS PROGRAM has been submitted by the College to The College of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as "TCNJ") in the amount of \$61,611.17; and

WHEREAS, TCNJ has approved the application entitled NEW JERSEY BONNER LEADERS PROGRAM as submitted by the College; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the operation of a project entitled, NEW JERSEY BONNER LEADERS PROGRAM is consistent with the philosophy and purpose of the College,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- a. The Board approves the application for the project entitled, NEW JERSEY BONNER LEADERS PROGRAM as submitted by the College to The College of New Jersey for the period September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2009, in the total amount of \$61,611.17.
 - b. The Board herein accepts the award of \$61,611.17 and authorizes the College President and/or her designee to implement the project.
3. WHEREAS, the College is offering courses in the Departments of History and Social Behavior and Psychology and Education, and

WHEREAS, the courses and programs in those departments are sufficiently related that they can be more effectively located in one department,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all courses and programs in the Departments of History and Social Behavior and Psychology and Education be transferred to the newly created Department of History and Social Science, and be it further resolved that the following departmental name changes be made:
