

BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE MIDDLESEX COUNTY COLLEGE

Minutes of the Meeting of February 25, 2009

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College was held at 9:13 a.m. in the Boardroom of Chambers Hall, located on the College campus. Members present were: Mmes. Power and Sutera, Dr. Piegari and Messrs. Antisell, Bauer, Finkelstein, Raja, Rivas, Sica and Tighe. Ms. Palumbo and Mr. Mulkerin were absent. Also present were President La Perla-Morales, Mr. Hoffman, Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.

In compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act" of the State of New Jersey, adequate notice of this meeting was provided as follows:

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees on August 25, 1999, authorized participation in the County College Joint Purchasing Consortium; and

WHEREAS, the Consortium currently requires the consistent supply of electric; and

WHEREAS, Middlesex County College has been requested to serve as the Lead Agency for the participating colleges in the Consortium; and

WHEREAS, Middlesex County College has acted as the Lead Agency to solicit and receive bids on behalf of the Consortium.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that based on the recommendation of the Director of Purchasing and Inventory and the Vice President for Finance and Administration a bid award be made to the following firm(s):

FINANCE COMMITTEE

Mr. Finkelstein moved, seconded by Mr. Raja for adoption of resolutions 1 through 4:

1. WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that \$73,211,998 is the amount necessary for the Current Unrestricted Fund and \$2,000,000 is the amount necessary for the Minor Capital Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees held a public hearing to review said budget on February 19, 2009,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- a. The budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010, in the amount of \$73,211,998 for Current Unrestricted Operations and \$2,000,000 for Minor Capital be approved; and
 - b. The Assistant Secretary of the Board of Trustees be, and she is hereby, instructed to forward a copy of said budget to each of the members of the Board of School Estimate; and
 - c. A public hearing by the Board of School Estimate with respect to the amount of money estimated to be necessary for Current Unrestricted Fund and Minor Capital Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010, shall be held on March 5, 2009 at the Freeholders Meeting Room, County Administration Building, New Brunswick, New Jersey; and
 - d. The Vice President for Finance and Administration be, and she is hereby, instructed to publish in the Home News Tribune, East Brunswick, NJ, at least seven (7) days prior to the date fixed for the public hearing and also set forth an itemized statement as to the amount of money which the Board of Trustees has determined to be necessary for the Current Unrestricted Fund for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010, which notice shall also indicate that said itemized statement will be on file and open to examination by the public between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, at the Office of the Vice President for Finance and Administration at Middlesex County College, Edison, NJ, from the date of publication to the date of the public hearing.
2. WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey and the County of Middlesex have funded construction, repair and replacement projects at Middlesex County College pursuant to the provisions of the County College Capital Projects Fund Act, L.1997, c.360; and

WHEREAS, projects to replace campus lighting replacements in the amount of \$1,000,000 and HVAC equipment

replacements in the amount of \$1,000,000 were approved by the Board of Trustees by resolution adopted on January 23, 2008, and the Board of School Estimate by resolution adopted on March 20, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the projects approved by the Board of Trustees on January 23, 2008, and the Board of School Estimate on March 20, 2008, were not funded by the County College Capital Fund Act, L.1997, c.360 in fiscal year 2009;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the above noted projects for fiscal year 2009 are hereby cancelled by the Board of Trustees; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees requests that the Board of School Estimate cancel the resolution adopted on March 20, 2008, fixing and determining that the sum of \$2,000,000 is necessary to fund the aforementioned projects and revoke the certification of the Board of School Estimate to the Board of Chosen Freeholders and the Treasurer of the State of New Jersey; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Assistant Secretary of the Board of Trustees submit a copy of this resolution to the Board of School Estimate.

3. WHEREAS, the President has recommended an increase in the tuition rates, for academic sessions scheduled for FY 2010, including Summer I session FY 2009, in order to provide a portion of the revenue resource for the services to be rendered; and

WHEREAS, the President has developed a Current Unrestricted Fund to provide educational and other services to the students of Middlesex County College for the year July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, said services are funded by students, the State of New Jersey and the County of Middlesex; and

WHEREAS, as required by the Higher Education Restructuring Act of 1994 a public hearing was held on February 19, 2009,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following changes in credit hour tuition rates, be approved commencing with the sessions scheduled for FY 2010, including pre-summer session FY 2009 as follows:

- a. In-county tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$91.00 per credit hour to \$97.00 per credit hour; and
- b. Out-of-county tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$182.00 per credit hour to \$194.00 per credit hour;

and

c. Out-of-state tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$182.00 per credit hour to \$194.00 per credit hour.

4. WHEREAS, the President recommends an increase in the technology fee from \$11.00 to \$12.00 per credit hour in-county and \$22.00 to \$24.00 per credit hour out-of-county and out-of-state, an increase in the general fee from \$16.00 to \$17.00 per credit hour for in-county and from \$32.00 to \$34.00 per credit hour for out-of-county and out-of-state for academic sessions scheduled for FY 2010 including Summer I session FY 2009 in order to provide a portion of the revenue source for the services to be rendered; and

WHEREAS, as required by the Higher Education Restructuring Act of 1994 a public hearing on these fee increases was held on February 19, 2009,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that these fee changes be approved as listed.

After discussion, the motion was unanimously adopted.
