

BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY COLLEGE

Minutes of the Meeting of April 28, 2010

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College was held at 9:01 a.m. in the Boardroom of Chambers Hall, located on the College campus. Members present were: Mmes. Palumbo and Power, and Messrs. Bauer, Finkelstein, Mulkerin, Raja, Sica, and Tighe. Messrs. Antisell, Piegari, and Shah were absent. Also present were President La Perla-Morales, Freeholder Rios, Mr. Hoffman, Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.
