

BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY COLLEGE

Minutes of the Meeting of February 23, 2011

The scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College was held at 9:00 a.m. in the Boardroom of Chambers Hall, located on the College campus. Members present were: Mmes. Brosnan-Barth, Palumbo and Power and Messrs. Antisell, Bauer, Finkelstein, Raja, Sica and Tighe. Messrs. Lisicki and Mulkerin were absent. Also present were President La Perla-Morales, Mr. Hoffman, Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.

In compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act" of the State of New Jersey, adequate notice of this meeting was provided as follows:

Chairman Power led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Tighe moved, seconded by Mr. Sica, that the regular meeting minutes of January 26, 2011, be adopted as presented. After discussion, the motion was approved.

ACADEMIC, STUDENT, ALUMNI AND MINORITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

Mr. Raja moved, seconded by Mr. Sica, for adoption of resolutions 1 through 4:

1. WHEREAS, the Academic, Student, Alumni and Minority Affairs Committee of the Middlesex County College Board of Trustees met and after identifying the need and relevance, and upon recommendation of the College President, unanimously approved a new Associate in Science Degree in Allied Health Pre-Professional,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees approves the Associate in Science Degree in Allied Health Pre-Professional.

2. WHEREAS, the Academic, Student, Alumni and Minority Affairs Committee of the Middlesex County College Board of Trustees met and after identifying the need and relevance, and upon recommendation of the College President, unanimously approved a new Certificate in Allied Health Pre-Professional,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees approves the Certificate in Allied Health Pre-Professional.

3. WHEREAS, an application entitled HEALTH PROFESSIONS OPPORTUNITY GRANT TO SERVE TANF RECIPIENTS AND OTHER LOW INCOME INDIVIDUALS has been submitted by the College to Bergen Community College, Lead Agency on U.S. Department of Health & Human Services Grant Partnership and Cooperative Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "BCC") in the amount of \$391,167; and

WHEREAS, the BCC has approved the application entitled HEALTH PROFESSIONS OPPORTUNITY GRANT TO SERVE TANF RECIPIENTS AND OTHER LOW INCOME INDIVIDUALS as submitted by the College; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the operation of a project entitled HEALTH PROFESSIONS OPPORTUNITY GRANT TO SERVE TANF RECIPIENTS AND OTHER LOW INCOME INDIVIDUALS, is consistent with the philosophy and purpose of the College,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- a. The Board approves the application for the project entitled HEALTH PROFESSIONS OPPORTUNITY GRANT TO SERVE TANF RECIPIENTS AND OTHER LOW INCOME INDIVIDUALS, as submitted by the College to Bergen Community College, Lead Agency on U.S. Department of Health & Human Services Grant Partnership and Cooperative Agreement for the period September 30, 2010 through September 29, 2011 in the total amount of \$391,167.

4. WHEREAS, a renewal application entitled MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM has been submitted by the College to the State of New Jersey, Department of Education (hereinafter referred to as the "State") in the amount of \$553,064; and

WHEREAS, the State has approved the application entitled MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM as submitted by the College; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-12J grants the Board the power to enter into contracts which it deems necessary and advisable with the State of New Jersey or any of its political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the State requires approval by the governing body of Middlesex County College for modifications to the grant budget,

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the operation of a project entitled, MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM is consistent with the philosophy and purpose of the College,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- a. The Board approves the renewal application for the project entitled, MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM as submitted by the College to the State of New Jersey, Department of Education for the period July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012 in the total amount of \$553,064.
- b. The Board herein accepts the award of \$553,064 and authorizes the College President and/or her designee to implement the project.
- c. The Board approves the submission of budget modifications for the project, entitled, MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE PARTNERSHIP.

4. WHEREAS, ON October 27, 2010, the College issued a request for proposals (“RFP”) from qualified firms for the development, design, installation and operation of solar photovoltaic systems at various locations at the College; and

WHEREAS, on December 22, 2010, the College received responses to the RFP from various vendors, and on January 26, 2011, the College awarded the RFP to BP Solar International, Inc. (“BP Solar”); and

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2011, BP submitted a letter to the College purporting to withdraw its bid submission; and

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2011, the College's attorneys advised BP that the award of the RFP constituted an enforceable agreement and that if the College were required to rebid the RFP it would hold BP liable for all damages incurred by the College; and

WHEREAS, as a result of BP's decision to not comply with the contract award, the College has determined that it is in its best interest to not accept any of the responses to the RFP and to reissue a request for proposals,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

1. The Board authorizes the Director of Purchasing and Inventory to reissue a request for proposals for a power purchase agreement to purchase electricity to be generated from solar photovoltaic facilities to be installed at various locations at the College.
  2. The Board authorizes the College's counsel and the College President, in conjunction with the Facilities Committee approval, to undertake legal action against BP as it deems appropriate to protect the College's interest.
5. BE IT RESOLVED that based on the recommendation of the Executive Director of Facilities Management and the Vice President for Finance and Administration payment be authorized to the following firm:

FINANCE COMMITTEE

Mr. Finkelstein moved, seconded by Mr. Tighe, for adoption of resolutions 1 through 4:

1. WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees has determined that \$79,071,662 is the amount necessary for the Current Unrestricted Fund and \$2,000,000 is the amount necessary for the Minor Capital Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees held a public hearing to review said budget on February 18, 2011,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED As follows:

- a. The budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012 in the amount of \$79,071,662 for Current Unrestricted Operations and \$2,000,000 for Minor Capital be approved; and
  - b. The Assistant Secretary of the Board of Trustees be, and she is hereby, instructed to forward a copy of said budget to each of the members of the Board of School Estimate; and
  - c. A public hearing by the Board of School Estimate with respect to the amount of money estimated to be necessary for Current Unrestricted Fund and Minor Capital Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012 shall be held at the Freeholders Meeting Room, County Administration Building, New Brunswick, New Jersey at a date and time to be determined; and
  - d. The Vice President for Finance and Administration be, and she is hereby, instructed to publish in the Home News Tribune, East Brunswick, NJ, at least seven (7) days prior to the date fixed for the public hearing and also set forth an itemized statement as to the amount of money which the Board of Trustees has determined to be necessary for the Current Unrestricted Fund for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012, which notice shall also indicate that said itemized statement will be on file and open to examination by the public between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, at the Office of the Vice President for Finance and Administration at Middlesex County College, Edison, NJ, from the date of publication to the date of the public hearing.
2. WHEREAS, The President has recommended an increase in the tuition rates, for academic sessions scheduled for FY 2012, including Summer I session FY 2011, in order to provide a portion of the revenue resource for the services to be rendered; and

WHEREAS, The President has developed a Current Unrestricted Fund to provide educational and other services to the students of Middlesex County College for the year July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Said services are funded by students, the State of New Jersey and the County of Middlesex; and

WHEREAS, As required by the Higher Education Restructuring Act of 1994 a public hearing was held on February 18, 2011,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the following changes in credit hour tuition rates, be approved commencing with the sessions scheduled for FY 2012, including pre-summer session FY 2011 as follows:

- a. In-county tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$99.00 per credit hour to \$101.00 per credit hour; and
- b. Out-of-county tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$198.00 per credit hour to \$202.00 per credit hour; and
- c. Out-of-state tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$198.00 per credit hour to \$202.00 per credit hour.

3. WHEREAS, The President has recommended an increase in the technology and general fee rates, for academic sessions scheduled for FY 2012, including Summer I session FY 2011, in order to provide a portion of the revenue source for the services to be rendered; and

WHEREAS, As required by the Higher Education Restructuring Act of 1994 a public hearing on these fee increases was held on February 18, 2011,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That these fee changes be approved as follows:

an increase in the technology fee from \$12.50 to \$13.00 per credit hour in-county and \$25.00 to \$26.00 per credit hour out-of-county and out-of-state, and an increase in the general fee from \$17.50 to \$18.00 per credit hour for in-county and from \$35.00 to \$36.00 per credit hour for out-of-county and out-of-state for academic sessions scheduled for FY 2012 including Summer I session FY 2011.

4. WHEREAS, Middlesex County College, as part of its solar project, needs to renovate / repair the affected parking lots; and  
WHEREAS, The estimated cost of repair is \$1.9 million; and  
WHEREAS, THE FUNDS AVAILABLE FROM Chapter 12 for this project total \$900,000; and  
WHEREAS, the County of Middlesex will provide up to \$1 million of funding for this project,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the College will proceed with the renovation / repair of the parking lot utilizing Chapter 12 and County of Middlesex funds.

After discussion, the motion was approved.
