

BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY COLLEGE

Minutes of the Meeting of February 22, 2012

The scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College was held at 9:00 a.m. in the Boardroom of Chambers Hall, located on the College campus. Members present were: Mmes. Manzoor, Palumbo and Power and Messrs. Antisell, Bauer, Lisicki, Raja, Sica and Tighe. Messrs. Finkelstein, Mulkerin, and Stewart were absent. Also present were President La Perla-Morales, Mr. Hoffman, and Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.

In compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act" of the State of New Jersey, adequate notice of this meeting was provided as follows:

- (a) On November 14, 2011, advance written notice of this meeting was posted in the lobby of Chambers Hall.
- (b) On November 14, 2011, advance written notice of this meeting was mailed to The Home News Tribune, 35 Kennedy Boulevard, East Brunswick, New Jersey and The Star Ledger, 205 New Brunswick Avenue, Second Floor, Hopelawn, New Jersey.

Chairman Power led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Raja moved, seconded by Mr. Sica, that the regular meeting minutes of January 25, 2012, be adopted as presented. After discussion, the motion was approved.

ACADEMIC, STUDENT, ALUMNI AND MINORITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

Mr. Raja moved, seconded by Mr. Sica, for adoption of the following resolution:

1. WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College (hereinafter referred to as the “Board”) and the State of New Jersey, Juvenile Justice Commission (hereinafter referred to as the “State”) have entered into a contract for the operation of a project entitled JUVENILE JUSTICE COMMISSION TRAINING PROGRAM (History & Social Science) for the period February 1, 2012 through August 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, a proposal entitled JUVENILE JUSTICE COMMISSION TRAINING PROGRAM (History & Social Science) has been submitted by the college and agreed to by the State in the amount of \$18,767; and

WHEREAS, R.S. 18A: 64A-12J grants the Board the power to enter into contracts which it deems necessary and advisable with the State of New Jersey or any of its political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the operation of a project entitled JUVENILE JUSTICE COMMISSION TRAINING PROGRAM (History & Social Science) is consistent with the philosophy and purpose of the College,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- a. The Board approves the proposal for the project entitled JUVENILE JUSTICE COMMISSION TRAINING PROGRAM (History & Social Science) as submitted by the College to the State of New Jersey, Juvenile Justice Commission, for the period February 1, 2012 through August 31, 2012, in the total amount of \$18,767.
- b. The Board herein ratifies the contract executed by the College President and the State of New Jersey.

#### FINANCE COMMITTEE

Mr. Bauer moved, seconded by Mr. Tighe, for adoption of resolutions 1 through 3:

1. WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees has determined that \$79,347,495 is the amount necessary for the Current Unrestricted Fund and \$2,000,000 is the amount necessary for the Minor Capital Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees held a public hearing to review said budget on February 17, 2012,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED As follows:

- a. The budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013, in the amount of \$79,347,495 for Current Unrestricted Operations and \$2,000,000 for Minor Capital be approved; and
- b. The Assistant Secretary of the Board of Trustees be, and she is hereby, instructed to forward a copy of said budget to each of the members of the Board of School Estimate; and
- c. A public hearing by the Board of School Estimate with respect to the amount of money estimated to be necessary for Current Unrestricted Fund and Minor Capital Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013, shall be held at the Freeholders Meeting Room, County Administration Building, New Brunswick, New Jersey at a date and time to be determined; and
- d. The Vice President for Finance and Administration be, and she is hereby, instructed to publish in the Home News Tribune, East Brunswick, NJ, at least seven (7) days prior to the date fixed for the public hearing and also set forth an

itemized statement as to the amount of money which the Board of Trustees has determined to be necessary for the Current Unrestricted Fund for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013, which notice shall also indicate that said itemized statement will be on file and open to examination by the public between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, at the Office of the Vice President for Finance and Administration at Middlesex County College, Edison, NJ, from the date of publication to the date of the public hearing.

2. WHEREAS, The President has recommended an increase in the tuition rates, for academic sessions scheduled for FY 2013, including Summer I session FY 2012, in order to provide a portion of the revenue resource for the services to be rendered; and

WHEREAS, The President has developed a Current Unrestricted Fund to provide educational and other services to the students of Middlesex County College for the year July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Said services are funded by students, the State of New Jersey and the County of Middlesex; and

WHEREAS, As required by the Higher Education Restructuring Act of 1994 a public hearing was held on February 17, 2012,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the following changes in credit hour tuition rates, be approved commencing with the sessions scheduled for FY 2013, including pre-summer session FY 2012 as follows:

- a. In-county tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$101.00 per credit hour to \$102.00 per credit hour; and
- b. Out-of-county tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$202.00 per credit hour to \$204.00 per credit hour; and
- c. Out-of-state tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$202.00 per credit hour to \$204.00 per credit hour.

3. BE IT RESOLVED, That the invoice for professional services rendered by the firm of Wilentz, Goldman & Spitzer for the period October 1, 2011 through and including December 31, 2011, be approved for payment in the amount of \$23,772.37.
