

BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY COLLEGE

Minutes of the Meeting of October 24, 2012

The scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College was held at 9:00 a.m. in the Crabiell Hall Brunswick Room, located on the College campus. Members present were: Mmes Palumbo and Power and Messrs. Antisell, Hahn, Mulkerin, Oras, Raja, Sica, and Tighe. Messrs. Finkelstein, Lisicki and Stewart were absent. Also present were President La Perla-Morales, Freeholders Tomaro and Rios, Mr. Hoffman, Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.

ACADEMIC, STUDENT, ALUMNI AND MINORITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

Mr. Raja moved, seconded by Mr. Mulkerin, adoption of the following resolution:

1. WHEREAS, an application entitled CENTER FOR ADULTS RETURNING TO EDUCATION (CARE) has been submitted by the College to the State of New Jersey, Commission on Education (hereinafter referred to as the "State") in the amount of \$24,999; and

WHEREAS, the State has approved the application entitled CENTER FOR ADULTS RETURNING TO EDUCATION (CARE) as submitted by the College; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-12J grants the Board the power to enter into contracts which it deems necessary and advisable with the State of New Jersey or any of its political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the State requires approval by the governing body of Middlesex County College for modifications to the grant budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the operation of a project entitled, CENTER FOR ADULTS RETURNING TO EDUCATION (CARE) is consistent with the philosophy and purpose of the College,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- a. The Board approves the application for the project entitled, CENTER FOR ADULTS RETURNING TO EDUCATION (CARE) as submitted by the College to the State of New Jersey, Commission on Education for the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 in the total amount of \$24,999.
- b. The Board herein accepts the award of \$24,999 and authorizes the College President and/or her designee to implement the project.
- c. The Board approves the submission of budget modifications for the project, entitled, CENTER FOR ADULTS RETURNING TO EDUCATION (CARE).

WHEREAS, Citrix Systems Inc., has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that Citrix Systems, Inc. has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the State of New Jersey / County of Middlesex in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit Citrix Systems Inc. from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract,

1. WHEREAS, the College performs an ongoing review of necessary policies; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustee of Middlesex County College has determined the following policies are necessary:

a. Disabilities Policy

The College shall ensure that the provisions of any and all public services are administered in compliance with all state and federal laws. The College shall provide reasonable accommodations except where such accommodations would result in a fundamental alteration in the nature of the College's services, programs or activities, impose an undue financial and administrative burden or may impose a threat to the health and safety of others.

b. Consensual Relationships Policy

Consensual romantic or dating relationships create an apparent or actual conflict of interest if one of the parties has the responsibility for supervision, evaluating or directing the other or has the power to influence the other person's educational or employment status. Therefore:

1. No employee may report functionally or administratively to a person to whom he/she is engaged in a consensual dating or romantic relationship; and
2. No instructor may teach or evaluate a person to whom he/she is engaged in a consensual dating or romantic relationship.

c. Supervision or Teaching of Relatives Policy

To avoid any actual or apparent conflict of interest:

1. No employee may report functionally or administratively to a relative.
2. No instructor may teach or evaluate a relative.

d. Campus Demonstrations or Gatherings Policy

Middlesex County College promotes intellectual inquiry and exchange in a respectful and civil manner. The safety of all participants is of utmost importance and the College will not approve any demonstration that will disrupt the mission or orderly operation of the College. Middlesex County College does not tolerate disruptive behavior at any event.
