Minutes of the Meeting of September 24, 2014

GENERAL

1. WHEREAS, Middlesex County College is committed to providing a healthy environment for its students, employees, and visitors,

BE IT RESOLVED That, the use of any tobacco, nicotine, or related product (including e-cigarettes) whether smoked, inhaled, chewed, or in any way ingested or consumed, is prohibited in all locations owned, leased, or otherwise utilized for College purposes, including College vehicles; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That at any Middlesex County College location, smoking and other prohibited activities noted above are permitted only in an individual's personal vehicle.

2. WHEREAS, Middlesex County College is committed to taking all steps to eliminate violence against women; and

WHEREAS, To that end, it will fully comply with the federal Violence Against Women Act and the Campus Sexual Violence Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the President is authorized to enact procedures designed to report domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking as separate statistics in its annual crime report.; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the President is authorized to adopt student discipline procedures to further the intent of the acts, including possible sanctions and protective measures that may be imposed following the final determination of a disciplinary procedure regarding rape, acquaintance rape, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault or stalking; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the President is authorized to develop education and training programs for students and staff as mandated by the acts, including: Disciplinary boards as to how to deal with domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking; Education programs to promote the awareness of rape, acquaintance rape, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking; Ongoing prevention and awareness campaigns for students and faculty; The procedures victims should follow; The rights of victims and the College's responsibilities regarding orders of protection or similar lawful orders issued by a court; Safe and positive options for bystander intervention that may be carried out by an individual to prevent harm or intervene when there is a risk of dating violence, domestic violence, sexual assault, or stalking against the person other than such individual; Written notification of students and employees about existing counseling, health, mental health, victim advocacy, legal assistance, and other services available for victims; and Procedures to implement the SaVE Act and regulations promulgated thereunder.

3. BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College appoints Erin Cyckowski to serve as a student member of the Board of Directors of the Middlesex County College Retail Services Corporation, effective, October 27, 2014.
