## ACADEMIC, STUDENT, ALUMNI & MINORITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

Mr. Raja moved, seconded by Mr. Mulkerin, for adoption of resolutions 1 and 2:

1. WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") and the Passaic County Community College (hereinafter referred to as the "PCCC") have entered into a contract for the operation of a project entitled, NORTHERN NEW JERSEY BRIDGES TO THE BACCALAUREATE DEGREE (NNJ-B2B) for the period commencing August 15, 2014 and concluding July 31, 2015; and
