BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY COLLEGE

Minutes of the Meeting of February 25, 2015

The rescheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College was held at 9:00 a.m. in the Boardroom of Chambers Hall, located on the College campus. Members present were: Mmes. Blanco-Jimenez and Power and Messrs. Finkelstein, Lisicki, Oras, Sica and Tighe. Mmes. Morana and Palumbo and Messrs. Antisell, Mulkerin and Raja were absent. Also present were President La Perla-Morales, Mr. Hoffman, Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.

In compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act" of the State of New Jersey, adequate notice of this meeting was provided as follows:

- (a) On November 18, 2014, advance written notice of this meeting was posted in the lobby of Chambers Hall.
- (b) On November 18, 2014, advance written notice of this meeting was mailed to the <u>Home News Tribune</u>, 92 East Main Street #202, Somerville, New Jersey.

Chairman Power led the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES

Mr. Tighe moved, seconded by Mr. Sica, that the rescheduled meeting minutes for January 30, 2015, be adopted as presented.

After discussion, the motion was approved.

CORRESPONDENCE

A letter of appreciation was received from Congressman Frank Pallone thanking the college and staff of Middlesex County College for hosting a discussion concerning President Obama's community college proposal. Congressman Pallone also thanked the three students who participated and spoke of their personal higher education experiences.

ACADEMIC, STUDENT, ALUMNI & MINORITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

Mr. Finkelstein moved, seconded by Mr. Sica, for adoption of the following resolution:

1. WHEREAS, an application entitled TAACCCT (Trade Adjustment Assistance Community College and Career Training) has been submitted by the College to Bergen Community College (hereinafter referred to as the "Bergen") in the amount of \$222,842; and

WHEREAS, Bergen has approved the application entitled TAACCCT as submitted by the College; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-12J grants the Board the power to enter into contracts which it deems necessary and advisable with the State of New Jersey or any of its political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the State requires approval by the governing body of Middlesex County College for modifications to the grant budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the operation of a project entitled, TAACCCT is consistent with the philosophy and purpose of the College,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- a. The Board approves the application for the project entitled TAACCCT as submitted by the College to Bergen Community College for the period October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015 in the total amount of \$222,842.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Board of Trustees submit a copy of this resolution to the members of the New Jersey Council of County Colleges and the Board of School Estimate for their consideration; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of School Estimate be requested to consider this resolution at a meeting of said Board at a date and time to be determined, in the Freeholders Meeting Room, County Administration Building, New Brunswick, New Jersey.

3. WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees has determined that \$78,438,662 is the amount necessary for the Current Unrestricted Fund and \$2,000,000 is the amount necessary for the Minor Capital Fund for said fiscal year July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees held a public hearing to review said budget on February 20, 2015,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED As follows:

- a. The budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016 in the amount of \$78,438,662 for Current Unrestricted Operations and \$2,000,000 for Minor Capital be approved; and
- b. The Assistant Secretary of the Board of Trustees be, and she is hereby, instructed to forward a copy of said budget to each of the members of the Board of School Estimate; and

- 4. WHEREAS, The President has recommended an increase in the tuition rates, for academic sessions scheduled for FY 2016, including Summer I session FY 2015, in order to provide a portion of the revenue resource for the services to be rendered; and

WHEREAS, The President has developed a Current Unrestricted Fund to provide educational and other services to the students of Middlesex County College for the year July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Said services are funded by students, the State of New Jersey and the County of Middlesex; and

WHEREAS, As required by the Higher Education Restructuring Act of 1994 a public hearing was held on February 20, 2015,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the following changes in credit hour tuition rates, be approved commencing with the sessions scheduled for FY 2016, including pre-summer session FY 2015 as follows:

- a) In-county tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$104.00 per credit hour to \$106.00 per credit hour; and
- b) Out-of-county tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$208.00 per credit hour to \$212.00 per credit hour; and
- c) Out-of-state tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$208.00 per credit hour to \$212.00 per credit hour.
