WHEREAS, by Amendment to the Bid Specifications, the College eliminated the work at the College Center from the Bid; and

WHEREAS, the installation of the sprinkler systems will require closure of the three Buildings at various times for the installation of the sprinkler upgrades; and

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WHEREAS, the College received only one bid from EACM Corp.; and

WHEREAS, the College upon review has determined that the bid for two of the three Buildings, if awarded, will cause the overall cost of installing the sprinkler systems in the three Buildings to exceed the budget for the project; and

WHEREAS, the College is considering changing the time period for working on the Buildings and the sequence of construction for the Buildings in order to minimize the disruption on the campus and the restriction on the use of the Buildings during construction,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, for the foregoing reasons the Board of Trustees hereby rejects the bid of EACM Corp.; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be provided to EACM Corp.; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the College Administration shall prepare new bids which will consider the overall budget of the College for the installation of the sprinkler systems in the College Center, the Library and Johnson Learning Center and changing the specifications as to the time period for working on the Buildings and the sequence of the construction for the Buildings.
