2. WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees wishes to reduce the current College tuition to high school students who attend college courses for credit at Middlesex County College to a flat rate of \$125 per course for a 3- and 4-credit course; and

WHEREAS, in order to reduce tuition the Board of Trustees is required in accordance with N.J.S.A.18A:3B-6c, to conduct a public hearing upon reasonable notice to members of the College community who wish to testify and have an opportunity to be heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees that a hearing shall be scheduled at 9:45 a.m. on November 20, 2018, in College Center, The Corral, located on the College campus in accordance with N.J.S.A.18A:3B-6c to provide an opportunity to the community to testify and be heard with respect to a change in tuition for high school students to \$125 per course with no fees for a 3- or 4-credit course;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the College shall have notice of the hearing published and posted in the manner provided in the Board policy.
