

High School Scholars Program

The High School Scholars Program provides eligible students the opportunity to earn Middlesex College credit while still in high school.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be 15 years of age at the time of registration and in their 2nd marking period of 10th grade (sophomore year) in high school.
- Applicants must complete a High School Scholars application and obtain proper signatures of approval from a parent or guardian and a guidance counselor prior to registering for a course.
- Applicants must meet all pre-requisites for the course selected. Placement testing may be required for certain courses.
- Home-school applicants must be 15 years of age at the time of registration and provide a transcript reflecting coursework equivalent to that of 10th grade.*
 *Proof of age and academic department approval may be required.

TUITION AND FEES

• Courses taken on-campus or on-line during Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters: \$135/course* (non-refundable) Students residing in other counties, states, and countries are not eligible to receive the HS Scholars program rate. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The placement test and/or official SAT scores are required for certain courses. SAT score reports must indicate student's name and scores.
- Students must adhere to MC's policies and procedures, as well as abide by MC's Student Code of Conduct.
 Please visit our College Catalog and review the Code before your course begins.
- Textbooks or Digital materials may be required for the first day of class and may need to be purchased from the Middlesex College Bookstore.
- Grades for MC courses will be recorded on a permanent transcript. Credit may be transferred to other institutions by requesting a transcript through Self Service.
